





The case design of Fourth Element's Pelagic diving watch is a testament to both durability and elegance.



The sapphire crystal covering the dial offers clarity and scratch resistance, while the exhibition caseback allows a glimpse into the Swiss-made Sellita SW200 movement.

This thoughtful combination of strength and sophistication makes the Pelagic as visually striking as it is functional, perfect for adventurers who appreciate precision and style.







